- FCFP has adopted a regional structure that allows our neighbors in north central Pennsylvania to partner with FCFP to build strong, healthy communities
- Awarded Grants and Scholarships in 2019 totaling \$4.9M
- FCFP received \$6.1M in donor contributions in 2019
- FCFP is a member of the Council on Foundations and is in compliance with National Standards

- Governed by FCFP Board of Directors representing the region

Council on Foundations (COF) (www.cof.org) is a trusted resource and partner to over 1000 community foundations through out the country. According to COF, community foundations are grantmaking publicly supported charities who administer the charitable objectives of its donors

Community foundations go beyond grantmaking. Many foundations are innovative facilitators of charitable resources helping to identify those needs considered most pressing.

Asset size of a community foundation can range from less than \$100,000 to more than \$1.7 billion

Foundations (including private) received over \$53 billion in 2019.

- 364 qualified nonprofits received funding
- \$4.6 million
- 110 Scholarship grants
- 95 students received an award
